



#6055-40 Tuber Panels

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Step 1 - Using Lexan scissors begin by trimming out the body panels along the scribed lines. For added durability we recommend using a sanding drum to round all corners of the panels.

Step 2 - Now with the panels cut out and sanded you can begin by attaching the front hood panel to the tuber chassis. Two holes are marked on the front of the panel these holes need to be cut out to allow the bumper brackets to pass through. (See Figure #1) The back portion of this panel secures itself by wrapping around the tuber down tubes. (See figure #2)



Step 3 - In order to install the rear panel you will have to remove the two screws holding the roll bar to the tuber chassis. With the screws removed Slide the roll bars into the panel and re attach the roll bar to the chassis, the front portion of this panel wraps around the chassis tubes for support. (See figure #3)

Step 4 - The roof panel will simply press into place and uses the roll cage bars as support.

Step 5 - The side panels also press into place and use the tuber chassis bars as support. (See figure #4)

Note: If you have trouble keeping you panels attached to the tuber chassis you can use thin double sided tape or small drops of shoe Goo for added support.
